### VII. AWARDS

Medals will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, and ribbons given to 4th-8th in both individual and relay events for the varsity meet.

Championship plaques will be awarded to the top male and female team.

# <u>Individual Recognition of Athletes:</u>

1st Team All-District will consist of 1st-3rd place winners in **individual** events. 2nd Team All-District will consist of 4th-6th place winners in **individual** events.

<u>Academic All-District</u> – Please submit your list of Academic All-District recipients to the meet director. Adhere to your school district policy on calculating this honor. Coaches must submit a list of recipients to Meredith May by 11:00 a.m. Friday, January 21.

<u>Swimmers and Divers of the Meet</u> certificate will be awarded with the use of Hy-Tek power point. The Coach of the Year award will be voted on by those who are current TISCA members.

### VII. ADMISSION

Tickets will be available through GO FAN. The link will be sent prior to the meet.

## IX. TIMING

An automatic timing system will be used which should include:

- A. Touch pad for each lane
- B. Two (2) back up push buttons per lane
- C. Two (2) watches per lane

8-line scoreboard will be running as well as the use of dive panels.

Teams must supply timers from their school as requested.

# X. **RESTRICTIONS**

Air horns, bells and other mechanical noise makers are prohibited in all District sessions.

# XI. ENTRIES

An individual may enter no more than two (2) individual events and two (2) relays, or one (1) individual event and three (3) relays. Each team may enter a maximum of four (4) individuals per event and one (1) relay per event. NFHS & U.I.L. rules apply. **Participants, including relay only participants,** must be listed on the Hy-Tek Zip File to be considered eligible to compete. Swimming and Diving entries must be generated by Hy-Tek Team Manager. The athlete's USA swimming ID must be included in your entry file. The meet host will not add them manually. Competitors in the diving events must be included in the Team Manager entries.

Send swim entries to mmay@lcisd.org by 11:00 a.m. Friday, January 21, 2022. Include a PDF of your entries. Please include your name, school address, work and home phone. A confirmation email will be sent once entries are received and successfully imported. The confirmation email will need to be checked for accuracy and a reply required. Once all entries are received and confirmed, a psych sheet will be sent out. If you do not receive an email, contact me ASAP.

5A/6A Dive sheets are due by 11:00 a.m. Friday, January 21, 2022. Girls & Boys 1-meter: divers will perform eleven (11) dives, five (5) voluntary, and six (6) optional. All dive sheets must be signed by the diver and the coach before the start of the meet. Dive sheet changes and/or corrections are due to the check-in table no later than one hour before the scheduled start of competition. Please have dive sheets filled out according to the 11-dive meet as stated in the NFHS Rule Book. Be sure to include divers on your entry sheets. Entry sheets can be found in your UIL Handbook. Please submit your Academic All-District list for swimming and diving with your entries.

# XII. MEET REGULATIONS

The meet will be governed by rules stated in the UIL Handbook and National Federation Rulebook.

### XIII. DURING THE MEET WARM-UP

The shallow end will have 4 assigned lanes open for warm-up/warm-down throughout the meet.
