Annual editions of the LCISD Secondary Course Catalog will serve as the exhibit for this administrative regulation. This document will be edited and approved by the Board annually and will serve as the official reference point for all course types as identified in EIC (LOCAL).

PRE-AP, AP,
ACADEMIC, AND
LEVELED
COURSES

Annual course offerings for Advanced Placement, Academic and Leveled courses shall be defined by the Secondary Course Catalog and will be weighed per EIC (LOCAL).

The use of course number suffixes will demarcate semesters or credit recovery courses. Pre-AP, AP and Leveled courses will align with the appropriate course type as identified in the TEA Academic Achievement Record data standards for transcripts

DUAL CREDIT /
ARTICULATED
COURSES

Dual Select and ATC/Select Tech Prep courses identified in the Weighted Numerical Grade Point Average section of board policy EIC (LOCAL), shall be defined as comprising all courses identified as either Dual or Articulated CTE Credit courses in the annual Secondary Course Catalog. Accordingly, these courses shall receive the corresponding multiplier as outlined in EIC (LOCAL). Course offerings shall be updated yearly to reflect changes in both Dual Credit and Articulated Credit agreements.

Dual Credit Courses will be identified with the suffix of "D" following the course number. This will align to the course type "D" as identified in the TEA Academic Achievement Record data standards for transcripts.

Articulated CTE Courses will be identified with the suffix "C" following the course number. This will align to the course type "A" as identified in the TEA Academic Achievement Record data standards for transcripts.

SELECT
ADVANCED
COURSES

Per EIC (LOCAL), all Select Advanced Courses will be identified in the annual Secondary Course Catalog as a selected CTE, fine arts, or athletic course in the fourth year or higher of a sequence. The Secondary Course Catalog will be updated annually to reflect changes in course sequencing.

All courses of this nature shall be identified with the suffix "W" following the course number in the Secondary Course Catalog. If a course is identified as both an Advanced and an Articulated CTE or Dual Credit course, students shall be awarded the Articulated CTE / Dual Credit multiplier.
